Pharmacy Services

Within the constraints of our drug list, medications for short-term illness are covered by the Health Fee. In addition, over-the-counter drugs are offered through our self-care cold clinic as a convenience to our students. Charges for medications not covered* by the health fee range from \$1.10 to \$317.60.
